
PRIMARY Level field trip (intermediate)

How does the eye see? How do our eyes adjust to the dark? Find the blind spot. How do conditions like shortsightedness and astigmatism interfere with your visual experience?

These are questions that students will be able to explore and experience during the program. They will also gain knowledge of the status of their own eyes, and claim ownership over the care of their eyes so they may cultivate good visual habits in their every day lives.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PROGRAM

Students will experience a basic vision assessment that will provide more insight on their visual status. Whilst these eye screenings do not replace a comprehensive eye examination, this is useful in alerting parents of issues that require early attention. This is important as uncorrected poor vision and poor eye coordination may impede a child's learning, especially when it occurs in their formative years.
